# PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS COUNT, TOO!

Every decade, the government conducts a count of the entire population. This count will happen between March and July of 2020.

### IT'S ABOUT ACCESS TO IMPORTANT PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES

Population counts determine how billions in funding for schools, hospitals, roads, and social services is distributed.

### IT'S ABOUT FAIR REPRESENTATION:

Census data determines the number of representatives Illinois has in Congress.



## HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CENSUS IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

## COUCH SURFING OR STAYING AT THE HOME OF A FRIEND OR RELATIVE

In March 2020, every home will receive a mailing from the U.S. Census Bureau with instructions on how to participate.

Forms can be completed online, by mail, or over the phone.

Visit my2020census.gov or call 844-330-2020 to participate.

Every person residing in the house should be counted, including those staying temporarily.

### STAYING AT A SHELTER, ON THE STREET, OR IN A CAR

Service-based locations (shelters, soup kitchens) will be counted between April 29 and May 1, 2020.

Counts of non-sheltered outdoor locations (tent cities, underpasses) will take place the evening of April 30.

If you are staying in a shelter or receive services in the community, talk to staff ahead of time to confirm when and how their location is being counted.

People experiencing homelessness can also self-respond. Visit **my2020census.gov** or call **844-330-2020**.

Responses are confidential by law.

The census will NOT ask about your citizenship status.
